Description:

This activity will be done in commemoration for Black History Month. The students will be able to learn to make an essay out of the words they have searched in a Word Search.

Objective:

The students will answer a word search which will give them words that are associated with Black History Month. After solving the word search, the students will relate each word with one another and make a short essay about it.

Vocabulary Terms:

1. **Black History Month:** an annual observance originating in the United States, where it is also known as African American History Month. It has received official recognition from governments in the United States and Canada, and more recently has been observed in Ireland, and the United Kingdom.
2. **Activist:** a person who campaigns to bring about political or social change.
3. **Equality:** the state of being equal, especially in status, rights, and opportunities.
4. **Freedom:** the power or right to act, speak, or think as one wants without hindrance or restraint.

Preparation:



The tutor must:

1. Print 20 copies of the worksheet.
2. Prepare a copy of the solution (may be printed or not).

Introduction:

The tutor will begin by showing the students a video about Black History Month. Instruct the students to note some important points while they are watching. After watching, ask some volunteers to share their notes with the class. The tutor will then discuss the vocabulary words together with the expectation for the activity.

Activity Steps:

<p>Step 1: Distribute the worksheet and blank printer paper to the students. Have them take out their pens.</p>	
<p>Step 2: Once all students are ready, have them start answering their Word Search. The students who will finish first will receive an extra point.</p>	
<p>Step 3: Let the students share some of the words they found and ask them what they think those words mean.</p>	
<p>Step 4: After the sharing, instruct the students to use the words from the word search to make a short essay.</p>	
<p>Step 5: Give the students enough time to finish.</p>	

Clean-Up:

Ask the students to turn in their word searches and essays to the tutor.

Conclusion:

Black History Month is celebrated month-long every February. It is celebrated to commemorate black people who showed bravery, talents, and uniqueness and proved that no matter what the color of your skin is, you should be treated with respect and equality.


